

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)

Our premises will have well trained staff who will have a responsible approach and good knowledge of the licensing laws. All staff will not be allowed to serve alcohol unless trained. The actual training will be done by an external company and will be a officially certified course - Bar staff training (working in licensed premises).

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We will refuse any alcohol sales to drunk or intoxicated customers, to use our premises in an orderly and respectful manner and staff will enforce these terms of use at all time. We will be vigilant in recognising any illegal drug or substance misuse and constantly work to prevent this from occurring.

c) Public safety

Our premises comply with all fire controls including risk assessments, means of escape, fire extinguishers. We will be mindful of any large crowds and manage the general safety of our customers.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

All noise will be kept to an acceptable level. The disposal of bottles will only be done between 10-00am - 12-00pm so as not to cause a noise disruption for neighbours. Our daily site schedules will mean that all rubbish and litter is disposed of quickly, keeping the site clean and tidy. Ample parking is available on site within designated parking areas.

e) The protection of children from harm

We will apply the Check 25 Scheme and only accept valid ID which includes the PASS hologram logo. Any events held for under 18's will have adult staff employed to ensure safety. A refusal book will be in operation where details will be kept of any refused person. All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian whilst on the premises.


