2. MINUTES

4. URGENT ITEMS OF BUSINESS

There were no urgent items of business.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The Chair noted that the planning officers would be outlining the main points of the application and any relevant additional information. She noted that the committee were given copies of all reports and plans in advance of the meeting, which they had adequate time to read.

**5. Application Number (Agenda Item B1) 2020/0137 – Plot 1, Futures Park, Bacup.
Construction of nursery building, with associated works, parking and access.**

The Senior Planning Officer outlined the application as detailed in the report and the update report including the site details, planning history, the proposal, consultation responses and notification

responses received. He also brought members attention to the Update Report and amended Condition 19 and amended recommendation following further comments received from the Local Highway Authority.

The Officer's amended recommendation was that authority is delegated to the Chair of the Committee and the Planning Manager to grant planning permission (subject to the conditions set out in the report and update report) once Officers (and the Environment Agency) are satisfied that the development will not be at undue risk of flooding and that the development will not unduly increase the risk of flooding elsewhere, and that Officers (and the Local Highway Authority) are satisfied that the development will not have any unacceptable impact on highway safety. Also that authority is delegated to the Chair of the Committee and the Planning Manager for any additional floor risk-related conditions (related to the above) to be authored and included on the grant of planning permission as necessary.

Ms J.Turner spoke against the application. Members asked questions for clarification purposes only.

Mr M. Kirk spoke in favour of the application.

In determining the application members discussed the following:

- Access
- Signage
- Existing nursery provision and business case
- Highways
- Parking
- Bin Stores

In response to questions from members the Senior Planning Officer advised that further talks were to take place with Lancashire County Council as per stated in the report and the update report to take into consideration the points raised above. The Planning Manager informed that existing nursery provision and the business case were not material planning considerations.

A proposal was moved and seconded to defer the application to allow more detail in relation to car parking, access and further consultation.

Voting took place on the proposal; the result of which was as follows:
