Hello Kelly

I just wanted to give you a better understanding of my project. I live in the vestry section of the church and will be transforming the upper part into an Art Cultural and Heritage Centre.

I am donating a large section to Bacup Natural History Museum, another section to local artists, and a smaller section for Rossendale council to use as Rossendale Tourist Information Centre.

The main function of the building will be the coffee shop, Bistro and wine bar, while members of the public enjoy the Art displays as well as the rich history and culture through the Bacup NAT showroom.

I will then have the occasional Jazz concerts, the monthly farmers market and occasional weddings.

The project will not be a 'Night Club' type of venue with daily concerts/loud events.

Farmers Market:

It is held on every 4th Sunday of the month from 10am to 3pm. I have around 15 traders that will arrive between 8am and 9am to unload on Fern street. Some traders unload on Burnley road as they are located at the front of the church.

Once they unload, I do ask them to move their vehicles across the road near the post office as it does not open on Sundays. There are also 8 spaces behind the Bingo Hall where traders park. I will send pictures.

I also own a Grand Piano and a complete sound system has been installed at St John. On a Jazz night the band will be using my equipment. I will make sure all Traders and band members park at Morrisons car park after 'drop off/unloading'.


All the below pictures were taken on Sunday 17/10/2021 between 10:00 and 11:00.

Detailed Plan of Event Traffic

0800-1000 Traders arrive to unload. Traders' vehicles will then be asked to park on:

-Harcourt street opposite St John since the Post Office closes on Sundays can accommodate 5 vehicles.





-Hall street is on the left side of St John, behind the Bingo Hall, it can accommodate up to 8 traders vehicles.





-Irwell Medical Practice Car Park on Rochdale Road, since the clinic is closed on Saturdays and Sundays, it can accommodate 40 vehicles and 4 disabled vehicles. It was almost empty on Sunday.

It is 292meters from St John















This section can accommodate 53 vehicles.


It is 300 meters from St John.








- Maden Centre Car park can accommodate 14 vehicles and 1 disabled, it only had 1 car parked this morning around 10:30. It is 290 meters from St John.



On street Parking is provided at eleven locations with the town centre area and the parking provision is for 119 parking spaces.

As you can see from my visits today there are more than enough parking spaces for both traders and customers visiting the Farmers Market.

Both customers and traders will be notified where to park, load and unload prior to any event. It will be advertised on the Facebook page as well as inside the church.

The website was built with a Find Us button that will show all the free car parks in the area and the walking distances. I have also added Morrisons Car park in a note under Find us as requested.

The link shows the capacity each public and private car park would provide.

Irwell Medical Centre on Rochdale road is closed on both Saturdays and Sundays so the 46 spaces would be available. I am a member of the Bacup Cultural Initiative along with other main businesses in Bacup. We do liaise with each other so we do not have events clashing with each other. I constantly liaise with the Bacup Royal Theatre so that we do not organise events on the same day. They use the Health Centre car park for their events. My weddings and large events would be on Saturdays/Sundays. Smaller events could take place during the week.

Whats on | BRCT (bacuproyalcourttheatre.com) The theatre organises 2 to 4 events per month.

These will be the main 2 venues in Bacup.

You stated that as a general rule LCC Highways would use an average 3 people per vehicle attending a wedding or similar event. Most weddings nowadays are on a smaller scale and I do not anticipate any issues.
