A decision was made at Lancashire Local meeting on 16th January to extend consultation period to end of February. Two residents' groups which had raised the matter were informed (Burnley Road Action Group and Cribden Residents Association). The proposed safety works were sent to both groups inviting their comments. To date neither group has responded but a further letter to each group is to be sent inviting them to respond with a deadline, after which a lack of response will be taken as indicating they have no objections to the proposed works. The works will then go ahead.	<u>Yes</u>
Rawtenstall	Condition of Town Centre Memorial Gardens known as Sparrow Park – Grass cutting now down on a regular basis – Lack of flower beds	NEAT Team Officer, Aled Thomas	Maintenance of Sparrow Park is a priority, the Parks team have been made aware of the situation	<u>Yes</u>
