**a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)**

The variations proposed do not alter the nature of the operation of these premises and in line with the government guidance we will continue to manage the premises in line with all four of the licensing objectives and all relevant legislation.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

- 1) Whenever the DPS is not at the premises a responsible person nominated by them will be left in charge of the management of the premises.
- 2) A CCTV system covers the premises internally. The system records, the data is retained for 31 days and made available for the authorities to inspect on request.

**c) Public safety**

- 1) The licence holder is aware of all & will ensure compliance with all existing legislation relating to public safety such as the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety Order) 2005.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

- 1) Signs will be displayed at the entrance/exit to the premises asking customers upon leaving the premises to respect the neighbours.
- 2) When entertainment is being provided all doors and windows will be kept closed.
- 3) There will be no external disposal of bottles after 2300 hours
- 4) The DPS or person appointed by them shall conduct regular assessments of the noise coming from the premises and outdoor areas and shall take steps to reduce the level of noise where they feel it is likely to cause a disturbance to residents.
- 5) All amplified music will cease at 2300 hours Sunday to Thursday and midnight on Friday and Saturdays.
