Upkeep and maintenance of Springfield Gardens. Dog fouling at Springfield Gardens.	Area Manager	The Area Manager confirmed that the gardens currently receive a basic level of maintenance which is 10 grass cuts a year. Flower beds are weeded during the summer months and pruned in the winter. An update on dog fouling would be provided by the Area Manager at the meeting.
The appearance of the roundabout at the top of Bolton Road North: - Some urgent actions were required to clean up the rubbish at the roundabout as it was letting down Stubbins Residents Associations' efforts to make their neighbourhood look better i.e. North West Bloom competition.	Area Manager/ Operations Team	The Assistant Area Manager for LCC, Highways and Environmental Management informed the Council that this is on a programme of works to be undertaken by RBC in partnership with LCC.  There are ownership issues, and discussion between the elected Members and Assistant Operations Manager was taking place to come up with ideas for what could be done.
Pot holes at Holly Avenue – is this RBC land and holes need to be filled.	Property Services	Facilities Team carried out site visit. The legal opinion is that we need to pass this to LCC as the Highways Authority. Property Services to write to LCC asking them to respond.
