The following data is taken from the Communities and Local Government Statistical Release extract 25 June 2009. Key headline performance figures are:

The national average for CTAX collection was 97% which is a decrease of 0.1% over 2008 -09. Rossendale achieved a collection rate of 97.4% for the year 2008 -09 which is 0.4% up on the national average.

The national average for NNDR collection was 97.8% which is a decrease of 1% over 2008 -09. Rossendale achieved a collection rate of 98% for the year 2008 -09 which is 0.2% up on the national average.

The Table below details the performance of the Lancashire authorities for 2008 -09.
