1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 For information. This report is to inform Cabinet of the outcome of the Council's Use of Resources 2008-09 assessment.

4. BACKGROUND AND OPTIONS

4.1 The Council under took a Use of Resources assessment for 2008-09 which scrutinizes how well the Council is managing and using it's resources to deliver value for money and better sustainable outcomes for local people. This

was conducted by the Audit Commission and is a requirement for all local authorities. This was the first year under a new, more stretching assessment framework. The Council's self assessment submission was coordinated through the Use of Resources Working Group.

- 4.2 The Council has been awarded a Level 3 overall score. **Level 3 denotes an organisation that 'exceeds minimum requirements – performs well'**. This is an excellent achievement for Rossendale and an improvement on last year's assessment. The hard work and commitment of Officers and Members should be acknowledged and celebrated.
- 4.3 The official final report of the Council's Use of Resources score are included in it's Organisational Assessment which will be published on the CAA 'One Place' website, with the results of the Lancashire Area Assessment was published on the 10th December 2009. - 4.4 The results have been communicated internally to staff and Members and a press release issued. The Council also worked with the NHS East Lancashire on a joint response to the red flag issue on health inequalities.
