RE: Application by Emily Alyse Green - Safe Self Storage, Carrs Industrial Estate, Flip Road, Haslingden, Rossendale

I write in relation to the above application for a licence to permit the performance of live music, dance, recorded music, making music, and the supply of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises.

I am resident at [redacted] Flip Road and unfortunately I wish to object to the above application on the following basis;

- I strongly disagree with the alcohol supply and consumption as I feel this will cause disruption to myself and my four young children as well as other residents in the area. Consumption of alcohol creates unacceptable behaviour.
- I believe live or recorded music or dance facilities until Midnight is unacceptable as this will cause disruption for myself and my family and other residents.
- I strongly wish to protect my children from harm and disruption as personal circumstances have seen their lives disrupted enough recently. I feel that the supply of alcohol and consumption attracts the "wrong crowds".
- I also believe this will cause much disruption everyday of the week and become somewhat a public nuisance.
- Public Safety also is an issue as at the present time we are able to let my children play freely in our grounds but I would feel somewhat threatened if the application was successful and there were crowds attending.

I trust you will take my points into consideration and believe the area, although somewhat industrial, is very peaceful. I do not believe this will be the case should a licence be granted.
