I am writing to you to object to the proposed event later this Summer on the old Haslingden Football Ground at Ewood Bridge.

I live [redacted] and upon the little information I have so far can see a couple of big issues with this event:

1. Parking will be an horrendous problem as there are no Car Parking facilities within 1 mile of this site – except for on the local streets, and with around 1000 tickets going on sale this is not simply a small issue.
2. The noise in and around the neighbourhood when the event finishes. 1000 people leaving this site will not be quiet – and this is supposed to be at about 10pm in the evening at the earliest.
3. The sanitary facilities for the number of people proposed have to be a worry. There are no fixed facilities and therefore the temporary arrangements could cause problems.
4. Can I just state that I have no objection to a one off event of music etc – but a thousand people event is far too large to be comfortable for the site and the neighbourhood.

I have had a brief conversation with Cllr Darryl Smith and I understand he has objected to this proposed event too – I have copied this email to him and other Cllrs who represent the area, the Eden / Greenfield Ward boundaries are only around 100 yards from the site so I have also copied in Cllrs who represent Greenfield Ward whose constituents will also be affected by this.
