Please accept this email as a police objection to the TENS applications received by us on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2016 in relation to land at the former Stand Athletic FC, Blackburn Road, Rossendale and a proposed music event on the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2017. The applicant being a Victoria Benson.

My objection is on the grounds of the crime & disorder licensing objective. This appears to be a substantial music event on a former football ground. This proposed event is going to run till at least 11pm with alcohol sales being requested. Its anticipated that up to 499 people will be attending. There are nearby residential properties that will be clearly effected by this event taking place. I have had contact with the applicant via email and brief details of the event have been passed to me but at this time I have not had chance to discuss Police concerns or see plans for the event or any risk assessments. The TEN's application for the event does not provide me with enough information to satisfy me that the crime & disorder licensing objectives will not be undermined if the event took place.

I propose to have further discussion with the applicant and I will inform you if an hearing is deemed not necessary by all parties.
