

NOTICE OF MOTION FOR FULL COUNCIL

UNDER PARAGRAPH 11.1 OF THE COUNCIL PROCEDURE RULES

The following Motion to be submitted to Full Council on the date indicated below:-	
<p>Council is concerned to learn that the future of the front desk at Rossendale Police Station is uncertain as Lancashire Police and the Police and Crime Commissioner struggle to maintain basic police services; a direct result of the £75million cut to Lancashire Police by the government.</p> <p>Policing and community safety are not issues that we should be cutting corners on, and while we understand the appalling pressure Lancashire Police are under, we are totally against this proposal.</p> <p>Council therefore asks the Leader to write to the Police and Crime Commissioner expressing our deep concern and opposition to this proposal. Council also asks the Leader to write to the Home Secretary asking her to urgently review the current funding that goes to Lancashire Police and asking her to reverse these government cuts which are now resulting in police forces across the country struggling to provide the basic and community policing which is so important and valued.</p>
