

Appendix D

The following has been agreed between the applicant and Environmental Health.

The canopy has been moved away from the party wall.

Air conditioning has been installed.

There will be no regular live music from the premises.

Doors and windows to be closed when live music is taking place.

Notices will be displayed from the premises asking people to leave quietly.

The side door of the premises leading onto Rockcliffe Road will not be used as the main point of access and egress.

Live and recorded music will stop by midnight on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays. Other days will be as applied for.

The sale of alcohol will stop by 2am on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.

The above agreement can be translated to the licence, if granted, in the following form:

Live and Recorded Music:

Between 1200 hours and 2300 hours Monday to Thursday.

Between 1200 hours and 0000 hours Friday to Sunday.

Supply of alcohol:

As applied for.

Late night refreshment:

As applied for.

Conditions which can be imposed onto the licence from the above agreement are:

There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public, notices in font size 16 or larger requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.

At all times that live music is being provided at the premises, all doors and windows shall be kept closed, save for access and egress.

When licensable activity is taking place from the premises, the side door which leads onto Rockcliffe Road will be used as an emergency exit only.
