That Citizens' questions, and answers to the same, should not exceed 3 minutes each.</li> <li>4. That Citizens attending the Council meeting have the right to ask one question each when all written questions have been answered if there is sufficient time left in Public Question Time and the question falls within the scope outlined in the Constitution.</li> <li>5. That Members have the right to ask one question each when all written questions have been answered if there is sufficient time left in Question Time and the question falls within the scope outlined in the Constitution.</li> </ol>
