In 2002 a group of determined local people formed Community Leisure Association of Whitworth Limited (CLAW) in a bid to re-open the swimming pool. This was achieved and the swimming pool, now known as Whitworth Leisure Centre re-opened its doors in June 2003.

Disaster struck in December 2003, when the civic hall was destroyed by fire and burnt to the ground.

In October 2006, the Riverside opened its doors for the first time, CLAW with the support of the Whitworth Community fought hard to achieve the fantastic venue we have today.
