WHEREAS the Council of the Borough of Rossendale (hereinafter called "the said Council") being the local planning authority for the said Borough of Rossendale are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Second Schedule hereto should not be carried out on land at Chatterton and Strongstry Conservation Area, Rossendale, Lancashire listed in the First Schedule hereto and shown edged red or coloured green on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Order").

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (as amended) hereby directs that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the land listed in the First Schedule of the description set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

The directions will apply in respect of development affecting:-

- a) all dwellinghouses within the area edged red on the plan annexed hereto, and
- b) all agricultural land coloured green on the plan annexed hereto

SECOND SCHEDULE

PART I - DEVELOPMENT COMPRISED WITHIN CLASS I REFERRED TO IN SCHEDULE I TO THE SAID ORDER AND NOT BEING DEVELOPMENT COMPRISED WITHIN ANY OTHER CLASS.

- 2. The erection or construction of a porch outside any external door of a dwellinghouse so long as:
 - a. the floor area does not exceed 2 square metres;
 - b. no part of the structure is more than 3 metres above the level of the ground;

PART II - DEVELOPMENT COMPRISED WITHIN CLASS VI REFERRED TO IN SCHEDULE I TO THE SAID ORDER AND NOT BEING DEVELOPMENT COMPRISED WITHIN ANY OTHER CLASS.
