

Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014

Public Space Protection Order

Means to Pick Up Dog Faeces

Rossendale Borough Council hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order comes in to force on **19th August 2019**
2. This Order applies to land specified in Schedule 1.

Offence

3. A person in charge of a dog on land referred to in Schedule 1 of this Order, shall be guilty of an offence, if, at any time, he/she does not comply with a direction given to him/her by an Authorised Officer of the Council to produce a device for or other suitable means of removing dog faeces and transporting it to a bin (whether or not the dog has defecated) unless:-

(i) That person has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so.

(2) Nothing in this article applies to a person who –

- (a) is registered as a blind person in a register compiled under section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948; or
- (b) has a disability which affects his/her mobility, manual dexterity, physical co-ordination or ability to lift, carry or otherwise move everyday objects, in respect of a dog trained by a prescribed charity and upon which he relies for assistance.

(3) For the purposes of this article –

- (a) a person who habitually has a dog in his/her possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog;
- (b) each of the following is a “prescribed charity” –
 - (i) Dogs for the Disabled (registered charity number 700454)
 - (ii) Support Dogs (registered charity number 1088281)
 - (iii) Canine Partners for Independence (registered charity number 803680)

Penalty

1. A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

Land to which this Order applies:

This Order will apply to any land which is open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access within the Borough of Rossendale.
