Subject: Edenfield Community Neighbourhood Forum - Proposed Residential Allocation to the west of Market Street, Edenfield (site H72)

Dear Anne, Tony, Warren,

Firstly we hope that you and your respective families are safe and well during these challenging times.

We are formally writing to you on behalf of the Edenfield Community Neighbourhood Forum for an update and response to a number of technical traffic, transport and highway queries that remain unanswered to date on Highways England matters. You will recall there was significant debate on the relationship of site H72 and the A56 at the EiP, which we and presumably the Inspector are still waiting for confirmation on. The October 2019 'Position Statement' between Highways England and the Council appears to still not offer any definitive answers to the delivery of H72, and in parts contradicts previous submissions made by HE where significant concerns were raised over the impacts of any future works on the A56, and the delivery of residential development on the aforementioned site.

Based on the above, and the information contained within our letter and all the written correspondence from Highways England, which is appended to our letter, we would be grateful for a clear and detailed response to the questions raised in this letter. It would be very useful for us to have a response on these matters on or before the 30th April please.

We look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
