Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Futures Park, Bacup, Lancashire, OL13 0BB, by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate
- 9. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Futures Park, Bacup, Lancashire, OL13 0BB, by 5 p.m. on Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Futures Park, Bacup, Lancashire, OL13 0BB, by 5 p.m. on Thursday 4 July 2024.
