M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

All staff will be competent and training will be given to all in particularly with regards to the sale of alcohol, drunkenness and underage persons, All persons will also be trained in the Challenge 25 rule. An incident book will be provided and held within the Bar area and records kept of all incidents for 18 months and available to the Licensing officer and Police when required. Policy for proof of age card is in place. We have Zero Tolerence to the use of drugs. Appropriate fire procedures are in place for public safety and illuminated fire exit signs are clearly visible. Signage asking for customers leaving to be quiet and have regard for the neighbours. A register of refused sales will be kept and maintained on the premises.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

An Incident book will be held on the premises and all criminal incidents will be recorded and also notified to the Police. Customers will not admitted with their own Alcohol at any time, customers will not be permitted to leave the premises with any open containers of alcohol. All Glasses, bottles will be removed from public areas as soon as the contents have been consumed. All bottles, cans will be disposed of in bins and will not be accessible to members of the public. We have a Challenge 25 policy in place.

c) Public safety

Challenge 25 policy is in place and all staff are trained in this. Appropriate Fire safety procedures are in place, fire extinguishers, fire blanket, illuminated fire exit signs, emergency lighting are all in place, all emergency exits are kept clear at all times, Taxi numbers are available to anyone requiring one to ensure safety when leaving. Signage for Zero Tolerence to drug use and are clearly displayed, especially in the toilet areas. There are no Cigarette machines or gaming machines on the premises.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

All windows are double glazed and non opening in the main room to prevent noise pollution . There is an internal porch / lobby available for customers awaiting transport which will minimise the breakout of any noise. Notices are displayed to ask customers to leave quietly with regard to neighbours, DJ's will finish 15 minutes prior to the event finishing. Staff will monitor the entrance to ensure that patrons do not congregate or cause disturbance. Customers will not leave with bottles or glasses or unconsumed alcohol.

e) The protection of children from harm

The Challenge 25 policy is in place. Photographic ID such as proof of age card, driving licence will be required. The complete exclusion of any person under the age of 18 from being able to buy alcohol. A register of refused sales will be kept and maintained on the premises. There are no cigarette machines or gaming machines available within the premises. All staff will be trained in the Underage Sales Prevention.

- A Permanent Residence Card issued by the Home Office to the family member of a national of a European Economic Area country or Switzerland.
- A current Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder indicating that the person named is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK, or has no time limit on their stay in the UK.
- A current passport endorsed to show that the holder is exempt from immigration control, is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK, has the right of abode in the UK, or has no time limit on their stay in the UK.
- A current Immigration Status Document issued by the Home Office to the holder with an endorsement indicating that the named person is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK or has no time limit on their stay in the UK, when produced in combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A full birth or adoption certificate issued in the UK which includes the name(s) of at least
 one of the holder's parents or adoptive parents, when produced in combination with an
 official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their
 name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A birth or adoption certificate issued in the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man or Ireland
 when produced in combination with an official document giving the person's
 permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or
 a previous employer.
- A certificate of registration or naturalisation as a British citizen, when produced in combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A current passport endorsed to show that the holder is allowed to stay in the UK and is currently allowed to work and is not subject to a condition preventing the holder from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity.
- A current Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder which indicates that the named person can currently stay in the UK and is allowed to work relation to the carrying on of a licensable activity.
- A current Residence Card issued by the Home Office to a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights or residence.
- A current Immigration Status Document containing a photograph issued by the Home Office to the holder with an endorsement indicating that the named person may stay in the UK, and is allowed to work and is not subject to a condition preventing the holder from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity when produced in combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A Certificate of Application, less than 6 months old, issued by the Home Office under regulation 17(3) or 18A (2) of the Immigration (European Economic Area) Regulations

2006, to a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights of residence.

- Reasonable evidence that the person has an outstanding application to vary their
 permission to be in the UK with the Home Office such as the Home Office
 acknowledgement letter or proof of postage evidence, or reasonable evidence that the
 person has an appeal or administrative review pending on an immigration decision, such
 as an appeal or administrative review reference number.
- Reasonable evidence that a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights of residence in exercising treaty rights in the UK including:-
 - evidence of the applicant's own identity such as a passport,
 - evidence of their relationship with the European Economic Area family member e.g. a marriage certificate, civil partnership certificate or birth certificate, and
 - evidence that the European Economic Area national has a right of permanent residence in the UK or is one of the following if they have been in the UK for more than 3 months:
 - (i) working e.g. employment contract, wage slips, letter from the employer,
 - (ii) self-employed e.g. contracts, invoices, or audited accounts with a bank,
 - (iii) studying e.g. letter from the school, college or university and evidence of sufficient funds; or
 - (iv) self-sufficient e.g. bank statements.

Family members of European Economic Area nationals who are studying or financially independent must also provide evidence that the European Economic Area national and any family members hold comprehensive sickness insurance in the UK. This can include a private medical insurance policy, an EHIC card or an S1, S2 or S3 form.

Original documents must not be sent to licensing authorities. If the document copied is a passport, a copy of the following pages should be provided:-

- (i) any page containing the holder's personal details including nationality;
- (ii) any page containing the holder's photograph;
- (iii) any page containing the holder's signature;
- (iv) any page containing the date of expiry; and
- (v) any page containing information indicating the holder has permission to enter or remain in the UK and is permitted to work.

If the document is not a passport, a copy of the whole document should be provided.

Your right to work will be checked as part of your licensing application and this could involve us checking your immigration status with the Home Office. We may otherwise share information with the Home Office. Your licence application will not be determined until you have complied with this guidance.
