Rossendale Heritage Futures Project

WHAT IS IT?

Valley Heritage Building Preservation Trust have secured £150,000 from Historic England to deliver a new 3 year project focussing on heritage assets across the Rossendale Valley. This is being matched with £15,000 from RBC and £3K from Valley Heritage over the project duration.



THE PLAN

To proactively address some of the many derelict and disused heritage assets across Rossendale

To put in place partnerships and establish a steering group, capacity and resources to explore new uses, unlock barriers and develop projects

EXECUTION

A project steering group will guide the delivery of the project with Valley Heritage being the accountable body. The steering group will be actively involved in refining the list of heritage assets to prioritise those most at risk and those that will gain tangible traction during the life time of the project.


